ORLANDO'S CITY BOARDS ARE YOUR WAY TO BECOME MORE ENGAGED IN CITY GOVERNMENT.

Citizen participation is vital to a democratic government. The City of Orlando recognizes the unique contributions made by volunteers and encourages involvement in the policy-making process through service as an advisory board member.

Most City Boards are created to provide advice and recommendations to City Council on diverse matters of public concern, including zoning, municipal planning, housing codes, downtown development, the parks system, public art, historic preservation, building codes and fire codes.

Individuals interested in serving on a board must complete a board application. Forms are available online at cityoforlando.net/boards, by calling 407.246.2251 or in person at the City Clerk's Office located in City Hall, 2nd floor, 400 South Orange Avenue, Orlando.

All board applications are reviewed by the Nominating Board. Recommendations for appointment or reappointment are forwarded to the Mayor and are subject to confirmation by City Council.
